- to provide a refreshing curriculum which displays an exciting and stimulating environment; promoting all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage and Early Learning Goals
- to promote a positive, open and honest partnership with parents by providing regular up-dated information on their child's progress through daily diaries and the Early Years Foundation Stage 'my story' packs
- to help children to form a socially caring and sensitive attitude towards other children and adults
- to promote care and integration of all children, recognising that special needs requirements are catered for wherever possible
- to strive to provide an inclusive environment which accommodates families' and children's needs arising from race, culture and religion
- to eliminate discrimination and racism by providing children with a positive image of other cultures using books, posters and other resources
- to provide a non-stereo typing environment by providing resources that equally encourages participation of both sexes
- to encourage relationships with the local community and external agencies where appropriate
- to offer support and INSET to staff to enable them to review and extend their professional development
- to promote British values and to prevent radicalisation by listening and monitoring any unusual events, comments or racial tensions within the Nursery
