General Day Care Rules

- All members of staff should be familiar with each policy document, particularly <u>HEALTH AND SAFETY</u>; <u>FIRE EVACUATION</u> PROCEDURE AND FIRE DRILL.
- Each room will display its individual day care rules to this particular age group.
- Hazardous Substances must be kept well away from and out of reach of the children to comply with government (COSHH) regulations 1999.
- Children's medicines should be recorded in the <u>MEDICINE BOOK</u> by staff, noting the <u>NAME</u> and <u>DOSAGE OF MEDICINE</u>. All medicines must be kept in a high cupboard or refrigerator or as applicable. Staff should always ensure that <u>PARENTS AND STAFF</u> sign the medicine book.
- <u>ALL</u> hot drinks are only permitted at meal times during which all children will be seated.
- Staff should wear flat heeled shoes when supervising children.
- Children should conduct themselves sensibly, quietly (where appropriate) and safely around the Nursery and should be discouraged from potentially dangerous activities e.g. running in the house; inappropriate climbing; and unruliness with others.
- CHILDREN MUST NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN ANY AREA OF THE NURSERY AT ANY TIME.
- Staff mobile telephones are to be <u>switched to silent</u> during nursery sessions and may be used only during staff breaks. See mobile phone policy.

DAY CARE RULES (BABIES)

All staff should ensure the following Day Care Rules are carried out:

- The protective aprons and gloves provided must always be worn when changing nappies or preparing and serving food.
- Changing mat must be disinfected after every nappy change.
- Hands must be washed after every nappy change.
- Sleeping babies should always be checked at regular 10 minutes intervals. 'Sleep chart' should also be updated every 10 minutes.
- Ensure babies are always secured by harnesses provided in prams, pushchairs and highchairs.
- Sharp objects i.e. scissors etc. must always be kept well out of the reach of children.
- Stair-gates should be kept closed at all times.
- Children's dietary requirements must be clearly displayed.
- Hot food / drinks must only be transported into the classroom once all children are seated.
- Music must only be played when appropriate and be age appropriate.

DAY CARE RULES (TIDDLERS, TODDLERS)

All staff should ensure the following Day Care Rules are carried out:

- Children must not climb onto the tables, chairs and windows.
- Children must be accompanied to the toilets at all times.
- Children must wash hands after each visit to the toilet, after outside play and before eating lunch and snacks.
- Protective aprons and disposable gloves must be worn during each nappy change.
- The changing mat must be disinfected after each nappy change.
- The nappy bin must be emptied after each nappy changing session. The front door must be kept closed when taking out nappies to the bin.
- Sharp objects i.e. scissors, craft knives etc. need to be kept out of the reach of children at all times.
- The stair-gates, where fitted, should be kept closed at all times.
- Children will be encouraged to use all toys properly e.g. no throwing.
- Double patio doors/windows must always be closed while in the garden.
- Music must only be played when appropriate and be age appropriate.
- Children's dietary requirements must be clearly displayed.
- Hot food / drinks must only be transported into the classroom once all children are seated.

DAY CARE RULES (JUNIORS, SENIORS, PRE-SCHOOL)

All staff should ensure the following Day Care Rules are carried out:

- Children must not climb onto the tables and chairs
- Children must wash hands after each visit to the toilet, after outside play and before eating lunch and snacks.
- Children will be encouraged to use all toys properly e.g. no throwing
- Children will be supervised when going up and down the stairs. They
 will be encouraged to hold the banister at all times and behave in an
 orderly manner.
- Staff will wear protective aprons and gloves when dealing with a wet, soiled or bleeding child.
- Children should always be supervised when using glue, paint, scissors etc. Sharp objects need to be kept out of reach at all times.
- Children's dietary requirements must be clearly displayed.
- Hot food / drinks must only be transported into the classroom once all children are seated.
